The South Dakota Family Planning Program assists men and women to determine the number and spacing of their children and maintain or improve general and reproductive health.

The South Dakota Family Planning Program staff provides education, counseling, nursing, medical, and birth control services.

All services provided by the program are strictly confidential and disclosed to others only with your written consent or as required by law.

Cost for services depends upon your income and family size. The South Dakota Family Planning Program is subsidized through Federal Title X & Title V dollars. Your fees & donations in addition to federal dollars allows us to continue to provide quality reproductive health services to those in need.

Services are provided for anyone regardless of age, gender, race, religion, nationality, or ability to pay. See back of brochure for more details as to where you can receive services.
